Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Public Workshop Thursday, June 16, 2022 and June 23, 2022

The Department of Transportation Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program applies to projects funded from traditional Department of Transportation (DOT) sources. It was established to ensure nondiscrimination in the award of state and federally funded contracts. Collier Area Transit (CAT), as a grantee of both the Department of Transportation and the Federal Transit Administration, is in the triennial process of establishing its goal for its DBE program. Collier Area Transit is recommending the following Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for applicable contracts during Fiscal Years 2023, 2024, 2025, beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2025. Collier Area Transit will be hosting a public workshop to discuss the goal established for the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise program, methodology, and registering to bid on projects.
